- Check with your airline to see what services they offer to families traveling with children.
- Visit TSA's website (<http://www.tsa.gov/travel/special-procedures/traveling-children>) for information on the airport screening process.
- Remember to allow enough time to get to the airplane, through security, board, etc.
- Have a plan for take-off & landing when ear pressure may bother your child.
- Bring new quiet toys or activities (like puzzles or crayons) to entertain your child while in the air.
- Pack a change of clothes for you and your child in case of spills or accidents.
